Play Our Way Grant Program: This \$200 million program aims to create a brighter future for women and girls in sport across Australia.

Grants will be available in two streams:

Facilities – for projects that establish and improve sporting facilities that are designed for women and girls and further encourage them to take part in sport and physical activity by better meeting their needs. Participation and equipment – for programs that encourage women and girls to participate and remain involved in sport and physical activity for life, by tackling barriers such as disadvantage or lack of equipment, and for programs that will lead to sustained cultural change in sport. <u>Visit the website</u> to view full funding guidelines.
